The University wishes to state unequivocally that the utterances attributed to the said lecturer do not represent, reflect, or in any way constitute the position, policy, or official views of the University of Eldoret.

The University upholds the highest standards of professionalism, academic integrity, respect, inclusivity, and responsible conduct in the discharge of its mandate. All members of staff, including part-time lecturers, are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with the University's policies, applicable laws, professional standards, and the obligations arising from their engagement with the institution.

Accordingly, the University has instituted immediate and appropriate disciplinary action in accordance with the applicable University policies, regulations, and principles of due process. The University will not hesitate to take all necessary measures where the conduct of any member of staff is found to be inconsistent with these standards.
